**CONSENT ORDER**

The Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois, Division of Professional Regulation (Department), by Laura E. Forester, Chief of Medical Prosecutions, and Anjum I. Usman, M.D., Petitioner, by and through her attorney John J. Richardson, hereby agree to the following:

**STIPULATIONS**

Petitioner presently is the holder of a Certificate of Registration as a Physician and Surgeon in the State of Illinois, License No. 036.083420 issued by the Department. Said license is presently on PROBATION. At all times material to the matter set forth in this Consent Order, the Department had jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties herein.

On October 29, 2015, Petitioner filed a Petition for Restoration. Subsequent to the filing of said Petition, the Department received information that, on or about April 1, 2014, Petitioner submitted a renewal application for her Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) Registration and did not disclose the formal complaints that had been filed by the Department (2009-04994 and 2011-11474). The Department filed a complaint (2016-01755) based on this information. Petitioner did not disclose this

on the merits as if this Consent Order had not been submitted.

Petitioner has been advised of the right to a hearing to contest the pending charges and the right to administrative review of any order resulting from said hearing. Petitioner knowingly waives each of these rights, as well as the right to administrative review of this Consent Order. Such waiver ceases if this Consent Order is rejected by either the Board or the Director. In addition, the Department and Petitioner stipulate that this Consent Order resolves all matters currently pending before the Department.

Petitioner acknowledges that she has freely and willfully entered into this Consent Order without any threat or coercion by any person. Petitioner has not relied upon any representation by or on behalf of the Department other than those set forth herein.

The Petitioner and the Department have agreed in order to resolve this matter that Petitioner be permitted to enter into a Consent Order with the Department providing for the imposition of disciplinary measures which are fair and equitable under the circumstances and which are consistent with the best interests of the people of the State of Illinois.

### **CONDITIONS**

WHEREFORE, the Department, through Laura E. Forester, Chief of Medical Prosecutions, and Anjum I Usman, M.D., Petitioner, through her attorney, John J. Richardson, hereby agree to the following:

- A. Petitioner shall take the Physician Edition of the Medical Ethics and Professionalism Course.<sup>1</sup>
- B. Petitioner shall submit proof of completion of said course to the Department's
