CEASE PRACTICE ORDER

In the Medical Board of California ("Board") Case No. 19-2010-204971, the Board issued a Decision and Order adopting a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, which became effective September 25, 2013. In the Board's order, Physician's and Surgeon's Certification No. C 50171, issued to DEBORAH METZGER, M.D. was ordered, revoked, revocation stayed and Respondent was placed on probation for three years with terms and conditions.

Disciplinary Order #1. "Monitoring - Practice," requires within 60 calendar days of the effective date of this Decision, Respondent's practice shall be monitored by an approved monitor.

The Respondent has failed to obtain approval of a monitor within 60 days of the effective date of this Decision. Thus, Respondent, DEBORAH METZGER, M.D., shall receive a notification from the Board or its designee to cease the practice of medicine within three (3) calendar days after being so notified. The Respondent shall cease the practice of medicine until a monitor is approved to provide monitoring responsibility.
