The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Jessica Laine Peatross, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician (locum tenens status) in the State of Oregon.

2.

On January 6, 2023, the Board opened an investigation after receiving credible information regarding Licensee's possible violation of the Medical Practice Act, specifically discipline against her California medical license from the Medical Board of California on or around October 6, 2022.

3.

Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order. Licensee understands that she has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183) and, by the signing and issuance of this Order, Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing, understands and acknowledges that this order is not subject to judicial review, and acknowledges and agrees that this Order was signed freely, without fraud or duress. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that Licensee engaged in conduct that violated the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(15) disciplinary action by another state of a license to practice based upon acts by Licensee that are similar to those described in ORS 677.190(1)(a) (*unprofessional conduct*) and

1 677.190(13) (*gross or repeated negligence*). Licensee understands that this Order is a public
2 record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and
3 the Federation of State Medical Boards.

4 4.

5 Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this
6 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions:

7 4.1 Licensee surrenders her Oregon medical license while under investigation.

8 4.2 Licensee must not reapply for a medical license in the State of Oregon for at least
9 two years from the effective date of this Order.

10 4.3 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining
11 to the practice of medicine.

12 4.4 Licensee stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall
13 be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

14 5.

15 This Order becomes effective the date it is signed by the Board Chair.
