**STIPULATED FINAL ORDER
GRANTING REQUEST FOR
VOLUNTARY LIMITATION**

1.

The Board of Medical Examiners (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers in the State of Oregon. Marilyn Mills Walkey, MD (Licensee) is licensed to practice medicine in the State of Oregon.

2.

By letter dated March 5, 1997, the Board was informed that Licensee had hospitalized for psychiatric problems later diagnosed as Bipolar Disorder. Licensee subsequently entered into an Interim Stipulated Order voluntarily withdrawing from the practice of medicine until completion of the Board's investigation and evaluation of Licensee's ability to practice in a safe and competent manner. By letter dated May 8, 1997, Dr. Jeffrey Thompson, MD, Licensee's current treating psychiatrist, reaffirmed the diagnosis of Bipolar Disorder and recommended that Licensee be allowed to return to her

1 professional activities. To date, the Board has received no adverse reports
2 from any patient or health care provider regarding Licensee's practice of
3 medicine.

5 Licensee and the Board stipulate to Licensee's resumption of
6 practice and resolution of this investigation contingent upon Licensee's
7 compliance with the following voluntary limitation, pursuant to ORS 677.410:

8 3.1 Licensee will continue treatment with a Board-approved
9 psychiatrist who will report to the Board on a quarterly basis regarding
10 Licensee's current condition, diagnosis and treatment plan.

11 3.2 Licensee will be responsible for notifying the health care
12 professionals and administrators with whom she works regarding the
13 limitations to her practice.

14 3.3 Licensee will adhere to her treatment program as directed
15 by her Board-approved psychiatrist and will not self-prescribe or treat.

16 3.4 Licensee's clinical supervisor shall make quarterly reports
17 to the Board regarding Licensee's status.

18 4.

19 Evidence of violation of the terms of this order shall be grounds
20 for disciplinary action by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.205.

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5.

Licensee and the Board understand that by resolving this matter through stipulation, Licensee waives her right to a contested case hearing under the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act, or to an appeal based thereon. Licensee and the Board further agree that this is a final order under Oregon law and therefore is a public record. This stipulation, however, is not a disciplinary action and is not reportable as an adverse action to the National Practitioner Data Bank or the Federation of State Medical Boards. This stipulated limitation will remain in effect until Board review pursuant to ORS 677.410.

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
