ORDER TERMINATING SUSPENSION

On December 18, 2012, the District of Columbia Board of Medicine (the "D.C.

Board") issued a Consent Order on December 18, 2012. The Consent Order suspended the

Respondent's license to practice medicine for a period of one (1) year from the date of the

execution of the Consent Order. The Consent Order required that during the suspension the

Respondent was required to complete twelve (12) hours of continuing medical education. The

Respondent was also required to pay a \$5,000.00 fine. The Consent Order ordered that should

the Respondent apply for reinstatement of license, he shall submit a reentry plan that would

include supervision of his D.C. practice for at least six (6) months.

On May 22, 2013, the Maryland State Board of Physicians and the Respondent entered

into a Consent Order in which the parties, based upon the D.C. Board's Consent Order dated

December 18, 2012, agreed to the suspension of the Respondent's license to practice medicine

until such time as the D.C Board reinstated his license.1

On February 6, 2014, the D.C. Board issued a Termination Order which terminated the

suspension of the Respondent's license to practice medicine that was imposed by the

December 18, 2012 Consent Order. The Consent Order also stated that the remaining terms would remain in effect.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Maryland State Board of Physicians that the Consent Order dated May 22, 2013, is of no further force or effect and the suspension is terminated; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order is a Public Document pursuant to Maryland State Gov't.
